1951

Baptist Hospital opens.

1956

Baptist Hospital joins with Pensacola Junior College to create the first Associate of Arts nursing program in the southern portion of the United States.



1960s

1964

Expansion provides space for one of the nation's first two outpatient surgery centers. An intensive coronary unit opens, one of the first four such units in the United States.



1966

The Baptist Employee Foundation is one of the first donors to support the newly established University of West Florida Foundation. The contribution establishes the relationship between the hospital and Florida's youngest university.

1972

Baptist Hospital completes the largest expansion in its history to add more services including those for stroke, orthopaedics and speech. Capacity grows for emergency services, cardiology, radiology and central supply.



1975

The Foundation of Baptist Hospital is established.



1976

The Women's Board of the Foundation is founded.

1979

Baptist works with the Santa Rosa County Commission to avert the closure of the county-owned Jay Hospital. Through the collaborative effort, Jay Hospital joins Baptist.

1994

Baptist enters joint venture to support Escambia Community Clinics (now Community Health Northwest Florida).

Baptist Hospital offers open heart surgery services.
