

NEW BAPTIST HOSPITAL CAMPUS UPDATE **DECEMBER 2022**

As 2022 comes to a close, we look back on the amazing progress made in the construction of our new campus on Brent Lane. At this time, nearly all the exterior work on the 10-story hospital and the six-story Bear Family Foundation Health Center is complete and work on the Behavioral Health Unit is moving forward at a quick pace. The park-like setting of the Town Square is becoming more evident as sidewalks take shape and outdoor furniture is placed beneath the towering heritage oak trees. Thanks to the outstanding efforts of our construction partners and the hundreds of men and women who have shared their special skills in building this transformational project, we remain on schedule to open September 2023. We are grateful for their commitment to our vision to increase access to quality care in a beautiful, nurturing setting.

Baptist Hospital

- Four of the building's 12 elevators have been installed.
- Drywall installation throughout the building is almost complete.
- Painting continues on floors 1-9.
- Installation of cabinets, tile, flooring and interior glass continues.

Bear Family Foundation Health Center

- Interior buildout, including drywall and ceiling grid installation, continues on all floors.
- Nearly all cabinetry has been installed.
- Rooms and offices on floors 1 and 2 now have doors and hardware.
- Most of the flooring throughout the building has been installed.
- Installation of plumbing fixtures continues.

Site

- Sod is being laid around the hospital and Bear Family Foundation Health Center.
- Installation of the irrigation system for landscaping is underway.
- Sidewalks are being completed.
- Outdoor furniture is being placed in the Town Square.

Behavioral Health Unit

- The concrete foundations and slab-on-grade are complete.
- Installation of the structural steel that provides the framing for the building is ongoing.
- Work on the mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems has begun.

Workforce and Economic Impact

- More than 600 workers are on site on any given day.
- \$20.7 million has been paid in construction wages to the local economy since January 2021.
- More than half of the workforce is local or minority.
- Efforts to recruit more local and minority workers continue.
