

NEW BAPTIST HOSPITAL CAMPUS UPDATE

We know a cancer diagnosis is frightening, and undergoing treatment can be stressful for patients and their families. That's why the design of the space for the Kugelman Cancer Center at the new Baptist Hospital campus focuses on patient comfort and convenience. Located on the ground floor of the Bear Family Foundation Health Center, all services to treat cancer will be offered in one easy-to-access location with its own dedicated entrance.

Other special features of the new cancer center are:

- Expanded space to enhance patient comfort and improve efficiency
- A total of 12 private exam rooms for patients
- Dedicated consultation rooms for oncology support services located close to patient care areas
- State-of-the-art equipment including True Beam linear accelerator technology for precise radiation therapy
- A dedicated lab-draw station
- 32 infusion bays for chemotherapy and other non-chemotherapy treatments and four private treatment rooms
- A dedicated pharmacy with special equipment for chemotherapy mixing

The new campus is on track to open this fall, and progress continues at a fast pace. Most of the work underway in the main hospital and the Bear Family Foundation Health Center involves finishes such as painting, flooring, door and cabinet hardware, and wall graphics that will help with wayfinding. Framing, sheathing and waterproofing of the exterior walls of the Behavioral Health Unit are nearly complete, and the interior buildout has begun. Campus-wide, final work on sidewalks, curbs and pavers is almost complete. The Town Square's irrigation system has been installed, and landscape planting has begun. Every day, more than 600 workers are on site to make our vision of modern health care a reality.
